

Stateline Animal Clinic Boarding Policy

Thank you for entrusting us to care for your pet while you are away.

Vaccination requirements for boarding your dog or cat are listed below. If your pet was vaccinated somewhere other than our clinic, please have proof of these vaccinations with you when you bring your pet in to board.

- For Dogs: a current Rabies vaccination AND distemper-parvo (DHLPP) vaccination are required.
- For Cats: a current Rabies vaccination AND feline distemper (FVRCP) vaccination are required.

Prior to entering the kennel, boarding animals are inspected for fleas and ticks. Any animal with these parasites will be treated at the owner's expense.

We provide food for boarding animals. If your pet requires a special diet, we ask that you bring the diet and provide any special instructions. If your pet takes medication that needs to be administered while boarding, please bring the medication with instructions in clearly marked containers.

We ask that you do not leave collars, leashes, toys, blankets and other personal items for your pet while boarding. We provide blankets and other bedding for your pet's comfort.

All dogs that board two nights or more get a complimentary bath the day of departure. If we discharge your pet early in the day or on a Sunday, your pet may still be wet from the bath.

If you decide to pick-up your pet earlier than anticipated, please call ahead so that we can have your pet ready for you.
